Privacy Policy

This policy (together with our terms of use and any other documents referred to on it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. By visiting www.chuf.org.uk (the Site) you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this policy.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 up to and including 24 May 2018 and the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 thereafter (the Data Protection Legislation), we are the data controller (i.e. the company who is responsible for, and controls the processing of, your personal data).

Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

Information you give us

You may give us information about you by filling in forms on our Site or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you make a donation, request information from, register for an event, sign up to our newsletter and if you report a problem with our Site. The information you give us may include your name, address, e-mail address and phone number, financial and credit card information.

Information we collect about you

With regard to each of your visits to our Site we may automatically collect the following information:

- technical information, including the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet, your login information, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform; and
- o information about your visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URL) clickstream to, through and from our Site (including date and time); products you viewed or searched for; page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page and any phone number used to call our customer service number;

this information helps us to build a profile of our users. Some of this data will be aggregated or statistical, which means that we will not be able to identify you individually.

Information about other individuals

If you give us information on behalf of someone else, you confirm that the other person has appointed you to act on his/her behalf and has agreed that you can give consent on his/her behalf to the processing of his or her personal data and receive on his/her behalf any data protection notices.

Monitoring

We may monitor and record communications with you (such as telephone conversations and emails) for the purpose of quality assurance and training.

Uses made of the information

We use information held about you in the following ways:

• Information you give to us

We will use this information:

- o to process any donations you make;
- o to provide you with any information you have requested;
- o to claim gift aid (where applicable);
- o to notify you about changes to our Site; and
- to ensure that content from our Site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.

Information we collect about you

We will use this information:

- o to administer our Site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;
- o to improve our Site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
- o as part of our efforts to keep our Site safe and secure;
- o to measure or understand the effectiveness of advertising we serve to you and others, and to deliver relevant advertising to you; and
- o to make suggestions and recommendations to you and other users of our Site about goods or services that may interest you or them.

• Information we receive from other sources

We may combine this information with information you give to us and information we collect about you. We may us this information and the combined information for the purposes set out above (depending on the types of information we receive).

Disclosure of your information

We may disclose your personal information to:

- analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of our Site;
- third parties, in the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we
 may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or
 assets;
- third parties, if all, or substantially all, of our assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by us about our customers will be one of the transferred assets; and
- third parties, if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of our donors, or others.]

Cookies

- Our Site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Site. This helps us to
